



**Subject: Concession for the wards of Kashmiri migrants for admission during academic session 2015-16-reg.**

Sir(s)/Madam(s),

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. 3-1/2012-NER dated 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2014, regarding provision of certain concessions for the wards of Kashmiri migrants in the matter of their admission to the educational institutions in other parts of the country during the academic session 2014-15. As Kashmiri migrants continue to face hardships, it would be necessary to provide concessions to their wards for their admission. Accordingly, it has been decided with the approval of competent authority to extend following concessions to the Kashmiri migrants in the matter of their admission in your institutions till further orders:-

- (i) Relaxation in cut-off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- (ii) Increase in intake capacity upto 5% - course - wise.
- (iii) Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/professional institutions.
- (iv) Waiving of domicile requirements.
